
The diagram above indicates the **MINIMUM** dimensions of an adult chair that the booster seat should be used on.


HEIGHT ADJUSTMENT Position A






HEIGHT ADJUSTMENT
Position B







CHAIR ATTACHMENT STRAPS

FOR INFANT FLOOR SEAT USE:

When not buckled in seat, children can escape and fall suddenly.

- ALWAYS use on floor with child secured in the restraint system.
- NEVER use on tables, chairs, or any other elevated surfaces.
- NEVER leave child unattended.
- **NEVER** lift this product with your child in it.
- NEVER use near stairs.
- NEVER use as a car seat or bath seat.
- ALWAYS STOW AWAY booster seat attachment straps when not in use as a booster.
- **DO NOT** use if any part is missing, torn or broken.
- DO NOT use any accessories or replacement parts unless specifically identified by the manufacturer.
- DO NOT position the seat under a window as it could be used as a step by the child and allow the child to fall out of the window.

FOR BOOSTER SEAT USE:

WARNING

Children have suffered head injuries, including skull fractures, after falling with or from booster seats.

- Check that booster seat is securely attached to adult chair before each use.
- Always use restraints until child is able to get in and out of booster seat without help. Adjust to fit snualy.
- Never allow child to push away from table.
- Never lift and carry child in booster seat.
 Stay near and watch your child during use.
- Prevent serious injury or death. Do not use in motor vehicles.
- Until child is able to get in and out of the booster seat without help (about 2 ½ years old), the child should be secured in the booster seat at all times by the restraining system. The tray is not designed to hold the child in the chair.

Cleaning: Do not immerse in water. Clean with a damp cloth and mild detergent.
